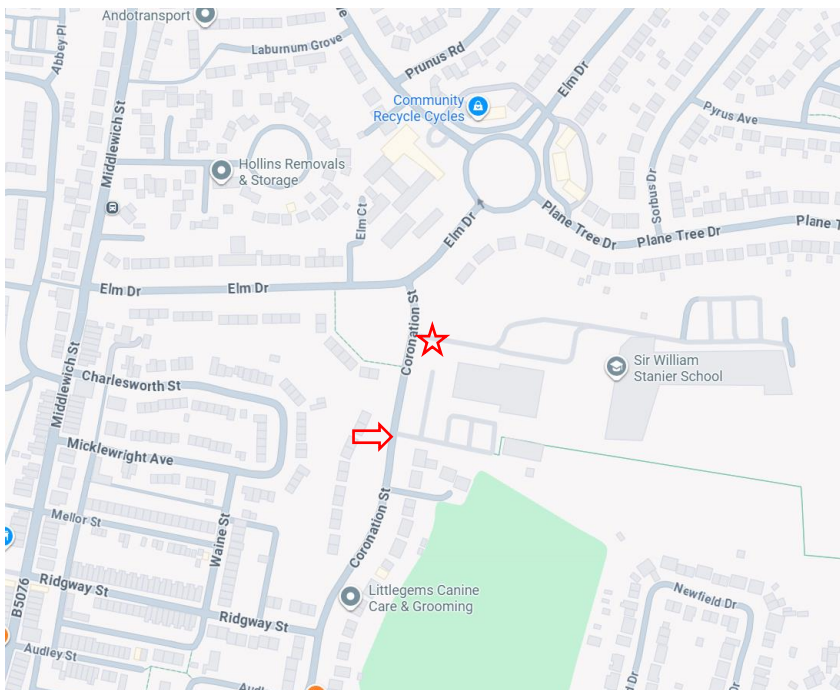




Racing at Sir William Stanier School, Coronation Street, Crewe, CW1 4EB

The venue will open by 07:30 each day, and the track will already be built. Note; we are running a normal club night on the Friday (for those not entering the Nationals). If you are planning on setting up your pit area on the Friday, please do not enter the hall until after 7pm, and please don't disrupt the club racing. While the building will be left as secure as possible, anything you leave at the venue is at your own risk.

The main entrance to the school is marked by the star, parking is allowed at the side of the roadway (do not block the roadway), not on the grass or paved area. The entrance to the additional car park is marked by the arrow;



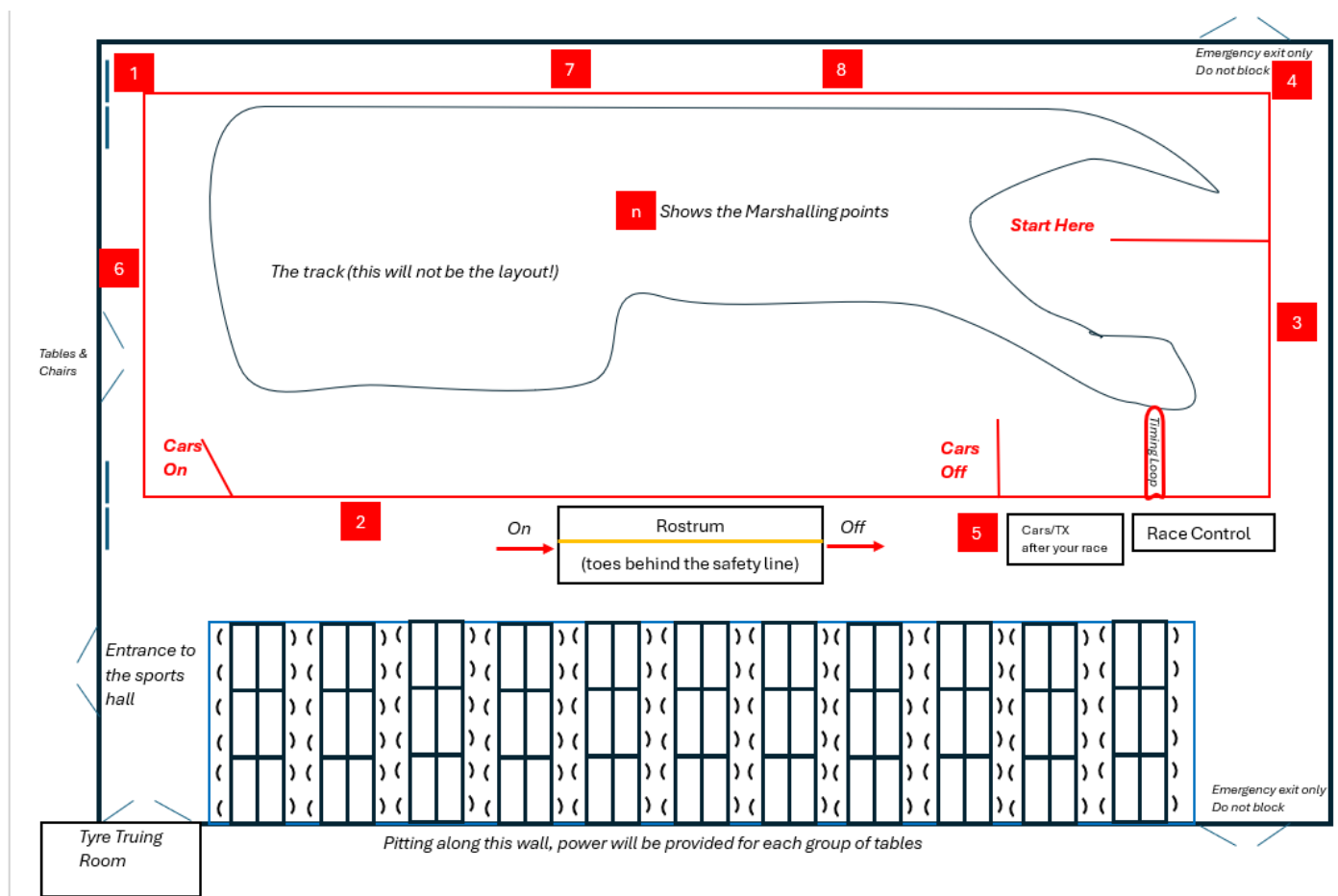
The entrance to the venue is shown below;



As you enter the building, the sports hall is to your right, and the toilets are to your left. Male toilets are the second door on the left, Female toilets the third door on the left.

Please bring an extension lead. Tables (sloped school exam desks) and chairs (hard plastic) are available, and you are welcome to bring your own chairs & tables. Please ensure you protect the school tables from dirt and damage, and please give them a wipe before you put them away.

Our general layout (including the position of the marshalling points) is the same for all our race meetings regardless of the track layout. Pitting is in the rows indicated on the plan, and there will be mains power to each row.



Mains power in the sports hall should only be used for charging, pit lamps etc. Not for kettles or heaters.

Any blowers/compressors/vacuums etc used for cleaning cars etc must be used outside the sports hall, to avoid disturbing the concentration of those that are racing.

All rubbish must be put in the bins provided, please don't drop anything or clean out your bodysells etc onto the floor, & truing of tyres only in the room shown.

The track will remain closed until the first round of practice.

We have also arranged for a food wagon to be on-site for the Saturday (Sunday is TBC), serving from 09:00am until 2:30/3pm. Please use this for all your food and hot drinks; we need them to want to come again.

After racing has finished, please stay and help us to pack the track away.
