Access to the school is from the main road, straight ahead through the green gates. Please turn right and follow the car park towards the sports hall.

There are two designated accessibility parking spaces available. Please note that the school may be in use by other clubs throughout the day, so parking can become limited. We kindly ask that all drivers park considerately and responsibly.

As this is a school site, smoking and vaping are strictly prohibited within the premises. Please use the designated area outside, beyond the green gates.

Building Access and Safety

Access to the pitting and racing halls will be via the main foyer, turning right on entry. To help maintain a comfortable temperature inside the building, please ensure all doors remain closed throughout the event.

In the event of an evacuation, please leave via the nearest available fire exit and proceed calmly to the main car park.

Please note: the fire assembly point may change. Any updates will be communicated clearly during the drivers briefing, so please listen carefully. The nearest Accident and Emergency department is Queen's Medical Centre, NG7 2UH, approximately 3.2 miles away.

Food and Local Amenities

Arguably one of the most important parts of any race meeting is the food. Fortunately, there are several options within a four minute walk of the venue:

Starbucks, Aldi, Lidl, Local chippy (closed on Sunday), Greggs

For evening meals, the nearest restaurant is a Harvester, located approximately 0.5 miles from the venue.



Event Format and Timetable

The weekend will consist of two separate race events, one on each day. WBMCC will also be hosting club night racing on the Friday evening prior to the event. Please note that the track layout for Friday night will be near identical however LMP will not be available for national competitors.

Access to help setup the pitting hall will be available from 19:00 on Friday.

Track and Facilities

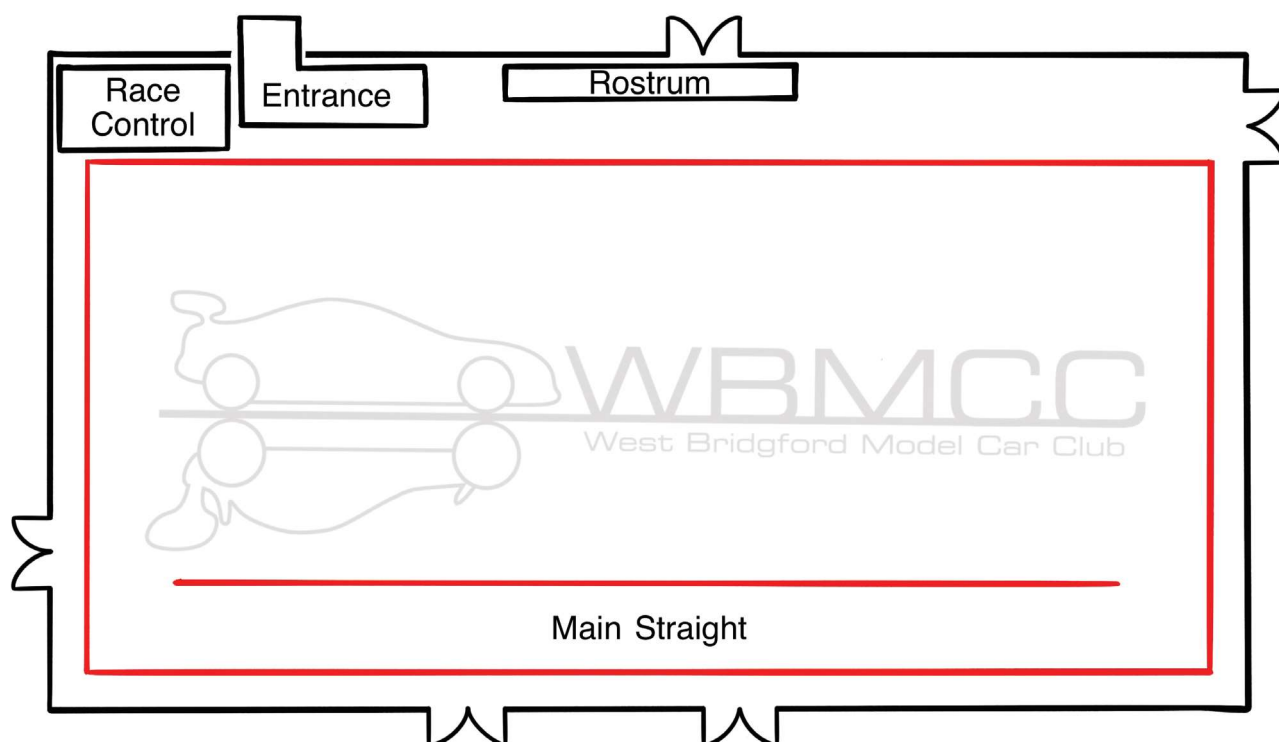
Racing will take place on a 31 x 14 metre Lindau carpet track. The surface is generally regarded as medium to high grip, with grip levels increasing quickly following practice and the first qualifying round.

The rostrum is a 1 x 8 metre platform, fitted with secure handrails and accessed via a single staircase.

Pull on and pull off zones will be clearly marked, and the timing loop will be located near to race control.

Live results will be available throughout the day via rc-results.com, with printed results also displayed in the pits.

Tyre truing will be done outside in a gazebo positioned next to the foyer entrance. Please respect this area and keep it clean as it'll be one of our dedicated committee members having to clean up any mess left over
