

Truggy + E8 Buggy Mini Series 2020 Round 1 Drivers Briefing

Practice Round

Where time and numbers allow we will attempt to run a practice round. The heats will be 5 minutes in length with a 2 minute warm up for the Truggy Class. E-Buggy class will be 6 minutes with a 1 minute rolling start.

If we are unable to run a practice round a 3 minute bolt will be added to the first round of qualifying. Please note all drivers and Pit Men/Women must wear face masks and the one way system must be followed at all times

Qualifying

There will be 4 rounds of qualifying. Truggy class heats will be 5 minutes in length with a 2 minute warm up. E-Buggy heats will be 6 minutes in length with a 1 minute rolling start. Both classes will be 3 rounds out of 4 to count. Please note all drivers and Pit Men/ Women must wear face masks and the one way system must be followed at all times.

<u>Finals</u>

Finals for the Truggy Class are 18 minutes from the B Final downwards. The A Final will be 30 minutes. E-Buggy Class finals are all 15 minutes in length. Both classes will include bump ups. Top 4 will be bumping up.

Please note at the time of writing this there will be 14 people on the rostrum and in pit lane. You WILL require a face mask or a face shield if you prefer

The Venue

Brookthorpe Model Car Club - Post Code GL4 0UT. When coming down the lane please be careful as you come down as some parts of the road to the venue is bumpy. So please be careful.


There will be a one way system for the Rostrum and the Pit Lane and this must be followed at all times. The one way system is outlined below.

The loop at the venue is at the start of the main straight, before the entrance to the pit lane (See picture below)

Pitting and Car Park

When you are parking at the venue please be mindful of the walk ways around the car park to the track. If you are going to be pitting in a team gazebo please ensure you are social distancing. The committee recommend that you pit on your own. Maybe behind the boot of your car. If you have your own tent we recommend that you use it.

<u>Marshalling</u>

When you are marshalling you require your own high vis vest (We recommend orange ones) and your own gloves. These need to be 'working' type gloves that aren't easily torn or ripped. Machine washable is also recommended.

When you are marshalling we ask you to marshal other people how you want to be marshalled yourself. Also please remember it is the marshals decision to leave their marshal point and enter the track. So remember you crashed it no one else!

PPE Required

PPE face masks are to be worn over the nose and mouth. These need to be suitable face masks and they should not be able to slip down during a race.

PPE face masks are required by all pit men/women throughout the whole day. Drivers need to wear face masks while on the rostrum for the whole day.

When you are marshalling you need your own high vis. We recommend orange. You will also require gloves for when you are marshalling. These need to be non-disposable gloves and hard wearing so they aren't easily torn.

The committee do have PPE available for purchase if you need any Masks $\pounds 1$ Hand Sanitiser $\pounds 3$ High Vis Vest $\pounds 3$ Face Shield $\pounds 3$

Pit lane

All pit men/women must wear a face mask and gloves at all times while in the pit lane. All pit men/women are to stand within their section which is marked out on the pit lane table by the white pieces of wood. Only one pit man/woman per car. Please note that pit lane is also one way
