GT8 ELECTRIC TECHNICAL RULES

Batteries: Hard case Lithium batteries are to be used with a nominal voltage of no more than 15.2volts. Any commercially available battery pack may be used up to 4S. All batteries fitted inside the car must be from the same manufacturer and display the same part number. The maximum charging cut-off voltage is 4.20v per cell in series (16.80vfor 4S). Organisers can check this voltage at any time during the event.

LiPo/LiFe drive batteries must be in a LiPo sack at all times when being charged or discharged. This applies to any discharging procedures. Except during a race. (Anybody found not doing this will be asked to leave the meeting on safety grounds).

A LiPo sack is defined as a receptacle designed for the purpose of charging/discharging LiPo/LiFe batteries and be of suitable construction so as to contain a LiPo/LiFe fire

Motors: Brushless motors up to and including 2800kva. Motor must have a 5mm pinion shaft. Reverse on any speed controller must be disabled.

Tyres: Rubber tyres only (NO FOAM TYRES) They must be commercially available. And use a 17mm hex mounting to locate the wheels. Quick change wheel mechanisms are not allowed. Tyre cleaning is allowed (but tyre additive is not allowed).

Chassis: Any part of the car may be changed during the race except the chassis (which may only be changed by permission of the committee). The chassis must have a minimum kick-up of 5 degrees in front. No carbon fibre chassis are allowed.

Transmission: Must be shaft drive only. Driveshafts must be used all round. All driveshaft must be made in steel (not lightweight materials like Aluminium or Titanium) (No belts allowed). Oneways, spools, locking "Torsion-type," or externally adjustable differentials are not permitted. Front & Rear geared Differentials can only be tuned with the use of silicone-based oils. No centre differential is allowed. (Ball differentials are not allowed/only gear differentials). Front and Rear differential gear ratios must be identical. (Front or rear underdrive or overdrive is not permitted).

Bodyshell: Bodies must be commercially available 1/8th scale GT1, GT2, Super GT, DTM, or V8 Supercar cars, 2 door GT bodies. Or at least a body with a separate wing like in touring cars. Height of wing max. 10mm higher than the rooftop. Maximum wing height 276mm Measurement taken with chassis plate on 20mm blocks. The roof cannot be designed in such a way that ribs or fins are used to manipulate the height. The measurement of the height of the car is measured on the highest point of the rooftop, excluding any air intake scoops, ridges or any other extension from the actual true rooftop. Rear wing width (MAX 310MM). Wing Chord(MAX 79MM). Wing end plates (MAX 40MM X 79MM). The body must be mounted to the sprung mass of the car at the front and the rear. No mounting on the suspension uprights allowed.

In GT EP Holes in the body shall be limited to a hole of maximum 60mm (6 square CM) may be made in the front windscreen to aid cooling. The antenna hole (Max 10 mm) plus the side windows and the rear window can be removed to aid cooling.

Additional cooling holes in the front where normally would be mounted the radiator of the respective body are allowed. If the dimensions of a single hole is bigger than $10 \times 12 \text{ mm}$ the area needs to be covered from inside with a corresponding grid

• An original plastic or foam bumper must be used at all times. It must be fitted on the front of the cars chassis.

GT8 NITRO TECHNICAL RULES

GENERAL:

All cars must have a de-clutching device and must have brakes capable of holding the car motionless with the engine running.

Any part of the car may be changed during the race except the chassis, (which may only be changed by permission of the committee).

ENGINE / FILTERS/SILENCERS:

Engine capacity shall not exceed .21cc and engines may not have more than 5 ports Carburettor intake venturi maximum 7mm internal diameter.

Engines must be fitted with an approved INS box type air filter, modifications to INS boxes will only be allowed for wet weather use (The only modification allowed is a 3mm hole in the base of the filter housing to allow for water drainage which must be plugged for use in dry weather) If the Race Director declares a "Wet Race" the use of specifically designed wet weather air filters are permitted

Engines must be fitted with a suitable silencer/muffler, preferably one made by the same manufacturer as the engine being used, all exhaust outlets must point horizontally or below, and must be able to meet BRCA approved noise levels for racing purposes.

Engines must be fitted with a mechanical failsafe device to close the throttle in the event of throttle linkage/ servo failure

FUEL SYSTEM:

Fuel tank capacity (including fuel tank and any or all fuel pipes/filters) shall not exceed 150cc. Fuel used shall have a maximum of 16% by volume of nitro methane, and all fuels shall only contain Methanol/ nitro methane and lubricating oil.

Height of wing max. 10mm higher than the rooftop. Maximum wing height 276mm Measurement taken with chassis plate on 20mm blocks. The roof cannot be designed in such a way that ribs or fins are used to manipulate the height. The measurement of the height of the car is measured on the highest point of the rooftop, excluding any air intake scoops, ridges or any other extension from the actual true rooftop. Rear wing width (MAX 310MM). Wing Chord (MAX 79MM). Wing end plates (MAX 40MM X 79MM). The body must be mounted to the sprung mass of the car at the front and the rear. No mounting on the suspension uprights allowed.

Holes in the body shell shall be limited to fuel tank, glow plug and needle valve access plus a small hole (Max 10mm diameter) may be made in the front windscreen to allow the use of a fuel tank lid release pull. A hole of maximum 60mm (6sq.cms.) may be cut into the front windscreen for cooling purposes, also the side windows and the rear window maybe cut or removed to aid cooling or refuelling. A small hole (Max 10mm diameter) may be made for the receiver antenna.

- The rear of the body may not be cut higher than 50.0 mm measured with a 10.0 mm spacer under the chassis plate when level.
- Details of all; front and rear lights, grills, air intakes and windows must be clearly contrasted from the surrounded paintwork. No parts of the car except the muffler outlet may protrude outside of the body shell, when viewed from above. No parts of the car except the antenna, body posts, transponder, may protrude outside the body shell, when viewed from the side wall. No additions or reshaping to the original moulded body shell (no body stiffeners allowed).
- Cuts outs: Only the following holes and sizes are permitted in the body shells: Maximum two holes may be cut with a maximum diameter of 60.0mm each. Note: holes may not be combined. Minimum distance between holes: 5,0mm. A hole with max. diameter of 35.0mm is allowed just above the engine cooling head for easy glow plug access but cannot be combined with any other hole, minimum distance between holes: 5.0mm.
- Both front side windows and rear window can be removed for ventilation, but not the side rear windows, which must remain intact. Small holes can be made for the body posts, transponder, carburettor adjustment and radio antenna (max. dia. of 10mm). The hole for exhaust pipe must be of reasonable size. No other holes are permitted.

• Wings and spoilers: - One wing and one spoiler may be mounted to any car (if the original full-size car had more, it is allowed to do the same). Wing and spoiler must be made from a flexible material. - Wing and spoiler may not be fixed to body with piano wire (they must be mounted directly to the body). - Wing and spoiler must not protrude outside the maximum height and width of the body (incl. the side dams). - Rear wings must be mounted in the same place as was intended by the body manufacturer.
