At Sanctioned events ONE type of control tyre will be adopted for the driven axle on 2WD cars and the rear axle of 4WD cars (same choice for both classes). The front axles tyre of 4WD cars will be limited to ONE type of control tyre. The non-driven axle on 2WD cars will also be limited to ONE type of control tyre., All control tyre choices are subject to conforming to rule 23.7. Sanctioned event host clubs will select the control tyres known to work best at their venue and the Section committee will subsequently approve the choices. The make and type of the control tyres to be used at National events will be specified on the National Championship entry form and also in the confirmation document. There will be no restriction on the number or compound of tyres used.				
Description\Justification				
Aimed to limited to need to purchase and carry multiple tyre choices to events which in most cases is unnecessary waste. Also simplify what can often be confusion tyre selection for those new to sanctioned events. The proposed rule wording still give scope for host clubs to nominate different tyres across the events (as now) and therefore retains fairness across manufacturers
