## Round 1 – Potteries Radio Control Model Car Club 25/26<sup>th</sup> April (page 1 of 3)

Welcome to PRCMCC (Potteries). The club was founded in 2022 with an indoor track based at the Michelin Sports Centre. After two successful years, the club expanded in 2024 by constructing a permanent outdoor circuit. Our outdoor track is laid with astro turf, designed to provide consistent medium grip without the use of sand. To maximise flexibility and keep maintenance manageable, we have deliberately avoided fixed obstacles. Instead, approximately 98% of the jumps and features are movable, allowing the layout to be refreshed regularly. This approach also enables two main straights, one at the front of the track and one at the rear, creating varied track layouts regularly.

The surface is level, though not to bowling-green standard, delivering a natural outdoor feel while remaining highly raceable in a wide range of conditions.

We hope you enjoy racing at the facility the club has built for the community and that PRCMCC continues to be a venue where drivers of all levels can compete, improve, and enjoy the sport.

**General information:**

Bingham Model Raceway (BMR) was established in 2017 by a group of local racers to create an outdoor off-road racing facility. The track has grown to become a popular RC race facility, based on a working farm with a flat field of over 2 acres, located around 2 miles from Bingham town center with easy access from the A46.

**Track and Facility:**

- The track surface is short pile, filled astroturf with high grip level.
- Features permanent jumps and table tops for varied layouts.
- Pitting space is available on either side of the track; weekend campers are advised to pit at the far end.
- Portaloos and fresh drinking water are available.
- A skip is available for rubbish disposal.

From the A46 (northbound or southbound), use the slip road to access Saxondale roundabout. Take the exit signposted "Saxondale"



As you come to the T junction at the end of the road, turn right.



This road will appear to come to a dead end, however there is access to the farm via a gate on the left.



**YOU ARE NOW ENTERING A WORKING FARM SO PLEASE KEEP SPEED DOWN TO 15MPH!**

Follow the road to the end, you will see some farm buildings on your left.



At the end of this road, it will change from tarmac to gravel. As you drive through the gate, turn right.



After around 50m, the path will flow to the left, over a crest and down to the right. Follow this path.



You will now see the entrance to the track in front of you through a third gate. Drive into the field where you will be met by one of the BMR team and advised where to park.

SRCC has been at its current location in Victoria Park since 1989, over the years the track has comprised of Grass, Concrete, cobble stone and Clay. The track now is Astro turf short pile with high grip generally. In the winter the club runs indoors at Banks Leisure centre 5 minutes away from the outdoor track. The club runs most Sunday throughout the year unless it collides with National events or large events elsewhere.

No Major changes since the 2023 national apart from we are now using hoses instead of guttering as the track markers which has proved very successful and we have removed some of the unnecessary areas of concrete allowing us to run a few more different track layouts and reducing potential damage points to the RC cars.

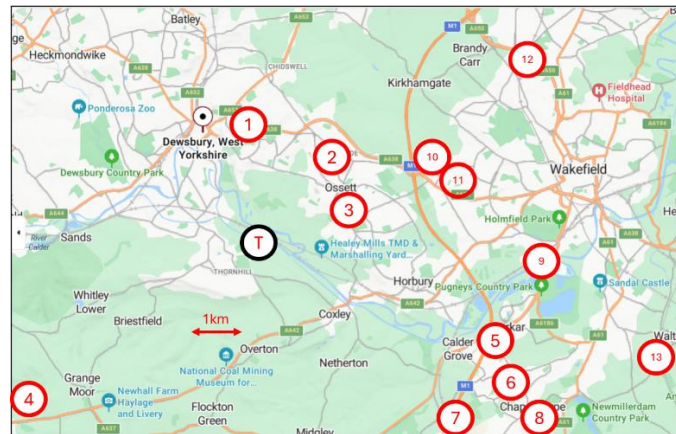
