This is NOT for use by campers to operate kettles, lighting, heaters etc. Please ensure when using an extension cable the cable reel is fully open and not coiled up. Please do not leave electrical items out overnight, damp getting into chargers and power supplies can also cause the power to trip out.

Camping
